



THE SITUATION OF UKRAINIAN REFUGEES IN ROMANIA

A GENERAL VIEW OF THE REFUGEE COMMUNITY IN ROMANIA

Background and Methodology

More than 1 million Ukrainian citizens have entered Romania since the beginning of the escalation of the conflict on February 24, 2022, of which more than 83,000 of them have settled in several cities of the country. The number of people entering Romania is fluctuating from one day to the next and it can be anticipated that it will vary depending on the intensity and geographical distribution of the conflict in the coming weeks or days.

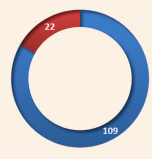
In order to understand the needs and intentions of the refugees, 132 people who fled the conflict and arrived in Romania were interviewed in the last month by the branches of the Red Cross in Botoșani, Brăila, Bucharest, Constanța, Galați and Tulcea.

The interviewed persons are selected from among those who have benefited from support from the Romanian Red Cross. The collected data will be interpreted statistically and will be used in the argumentation of SNCRR's activity plans.

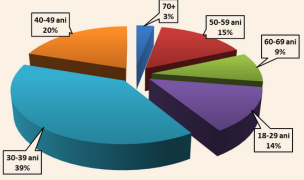
Demography

Age of respondents



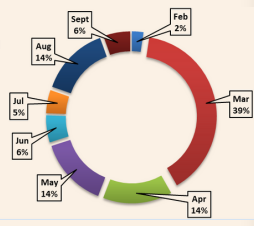
83.72% of the respondents came to Romania accompanied by other people:

Immigration in Romania

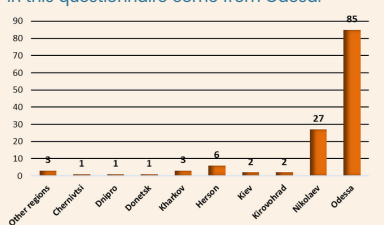
The date they arrived in Romania

More than half of the respondents who took part in this questionnaire come from Odesa.

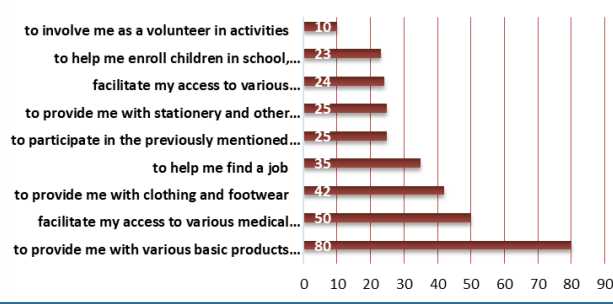


Relationship with RRC

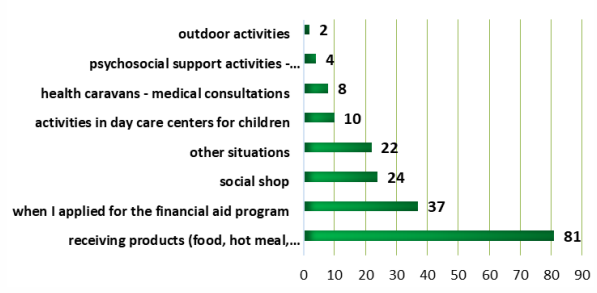
Increasing the quality of life

Ongoing CRR activities

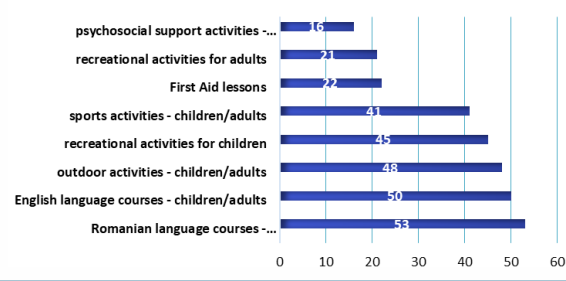

Intentions

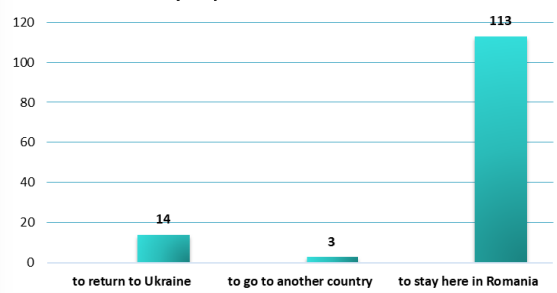
Resolutions - desired activities
